SRF's new refrigerant blend is ASHRAE listed

Indian refrigerant manufacturer, SRF Ltd. has said that it has obtained certification from the American Society of Heating, Refrigeration, Air-conditioning Engineers (ASHRAE) for its R-467A, a new, low-GWP (Global Warming Potential) refrigerant blend for stationary air-conditioning applications. It is the first-ever refrigerant from India to have received this certification.

Developed using in-house, patented technology, R-467A is a non-toxic, mildly flammable refrigerant designed mainly for use in stationary air-conditioning
